

#### **Poster Guidelines:**

- Maximum poster size: 44" x 44" (112 cm x 112 cm).
- · Suggested minimum font sizes:
  - 1. Title: 36-point type
  - 2. List of authors: 25-point type
  - 3. Body copy (double-spaced text): 15-point type
  - 4. Use high contrast colors and avoid red-green pairings to aid those with color blindness.

Print a high-resolution copy of your poster for onsite presentation (size must not exceed 44" x 44" [112 cm x 112 cm]).

#### Best YRF (Young Research Forum) Presentation Award

This award is for young investigators, post-graduate students, post-doctoral fellows, trainees, and junior faculty with up to 5 years of research experience.

#### **Eligibility Criteria:**

- · Must be a registered participant of the conference.
- · Must present research (either as an oral or poster presentation).
- Each young researcher/young scientist can submit only one paper (as first author or co-author).
- · Age limit: Under 35 years.
- · Chair & Co-Chair will select the best presentation.

#### **Best Women Presentation Award**

This award recognizes the most outstanding oral presentation by a woman at the conference.

### **Eligibility Criteria:**

- · must be registered participants of the conference.
- · Must present research (either as an oral or poster presentation).
- Presenters Demonstrated ability to explain research clearly and answer questions effectively.
- · Chair & Co-Chair will select the best presentation
